1. General

1.1 Stock

The stock of titles in the Database Information System was increased by approximately 300 titles in 2022. At the end of the year, the Database Information System comprised 14,524 titles, including 6,199 free databases.




Fig. 1: Development of the title stock in DBIS in the years 2015-2022

1.2 Usage

In 2022, approximately 6 million database calls are recorded via the Database Information System. Use of the service has been declining somewhat in recent years. Further development should continue to be monitored, especially against the backdrop of the modernisation and networking of DBIS as part of the DFG project, which will be carried out from 2020 to 2024.




Fig. 2: Development of total accesses to databases via DBIS in the years 2008-2022.




Fig. 3: Development of DBIS user libraries in the years 2009 - 2022

The number of DBIS participants increased by 5 institutions to 350 user libraries in the year under review (see Figure 3).
